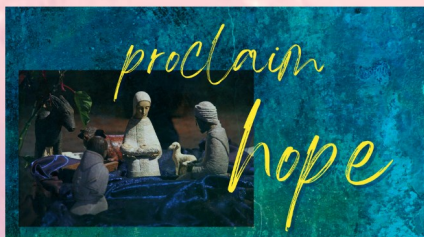
Third Sunday of Advent
