#### Don Bosco Girls' Home



## Ilumine Our Dark Hearts Jesus!



"Again Jesus spoke to them, saying 'I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

John 8:12 (ESV)

John wrote his gospel to the Jews and the Greeks. A bulls-eye verse was meant to smack both populations right between the eyes with the truth of who Jesus is. Jesus pronounces one of the seven "I AM" arrows in this verse. These arrows hit their bulls-eyes each time.

His statement caused consternation for the Jews. To them, the Light of the World, is the Torah. How dare Jesus says HE is the light.

"I am the Lord; I have called you in righteousness: I will take you by the hand and keep you; I will give you as a covenant for the people, a light for the nations, to open the eyes that are blind, to bring out the prisoners from the dungeon, from the prison those who sit in darkness." Isaiah 42:6-7 (ESV)

The Greeks did a double take because they believed that Apollo is the Light because he was associated with the sun. How could Jesus be the Light?

Today, we too need the "Light of the World" arrow to pierce our hearts and minds. We live in dark times and many people are cowering in the dark, unsure of what lies ahead. We need Jesus. He is the Light that will illuminate our darkness. Only He can bring us out of the dark.
